Update communication to timelines per by-laws and BOT Approval

- Per by-laws, Part Four-Article 1, to be eligible to vote in the General Body Meeting or in the election of trustees, an individual or a family must be an ICM member for 1 year. 1 year is defined as 12 months.
- To be eligible for voting, you must be or become a member before March 31st of the previous year AND also have your membership renewed the following year in time to be considered a full year member. *Example:* You must become a new member before March 31, 2022 and renew your membership 30 days before the General Body meeting in 2023 to be considered a voting member in 2023.
- Per the bylaws to be eligible to be nominated for a BOT position, you must be a member for at least 2 consecutive years and an active ICM volunteer for 2 years.
 - *Example:* You must be or became a member before March 31, 2021, renew your 2022 membership and renew your 2023 membership 30 days before the General Body meeting in 2023 to be considered a BOT nominee in 2023. This is in addition to being an ICM volunteer for 2 years.
- Per the bylaws, only Individual and Family Memberships will be offered. Going forward we will not be offering Student Membership.
- \$3,000 lifetime membership to be offered as well.

Membership Dues

Current Membership dues

- \$50/Individual and \$100/family
- No benefits besides voting privilege
- Recommendation
 - Per ICM Bylaws, Part 3, Article 3 – “Membership dues shall be recommended by the Board of Trustees and approved by the General Body.”
 - BOT has the right to waive partially or fully any member’s dues.
 - Revise the dues to \$150/\$250.
 - Offer 10% discount to the members for ICM facility rental.
- Other Area Masajid
 - ISB - \$120 individual / \$240 Family – Discount on Hall Rental and other programs
 - MCC - \$100 individual / \$200 Family – Discount on Hall Rental
 - DAT - \$100 individual / \$200 Family – No Discount specified.
- Requesting motion for the GB to vote for the membership to be \$150/\$250.
 - Alternately, keep in line with other Masajid and go with \$100/\$200.

Electronic Voting

- Growing interest among members to vote in the General Body
- Schedule conflicts with members to be able to cast their votes
- Mandate the next Election Commissioner to
 - Research the feasibility of allowing electronic voting option.
 - Propose solutions to the Secretary and the BOT within 120 days for review.
 - BOT to review options and solicit input from the community via Survey, Town Hall or General Body Meeting.
 - If GB agrees in 2023, ICM By-laws to be amended to refine Part 5, Article 8 to include electronic voting as an option.

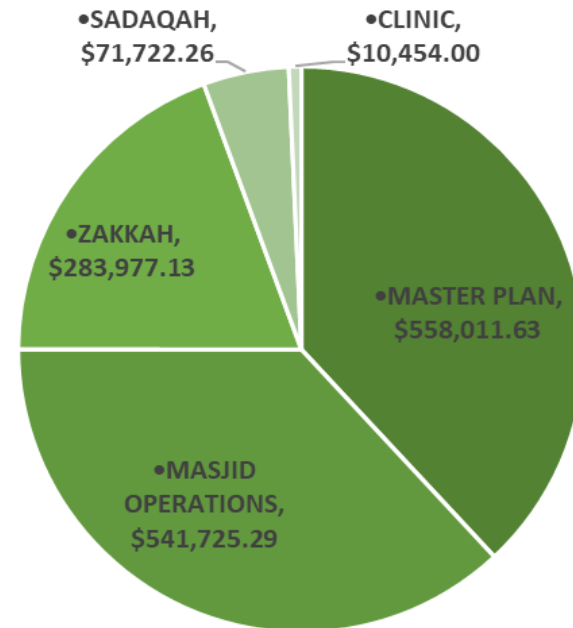

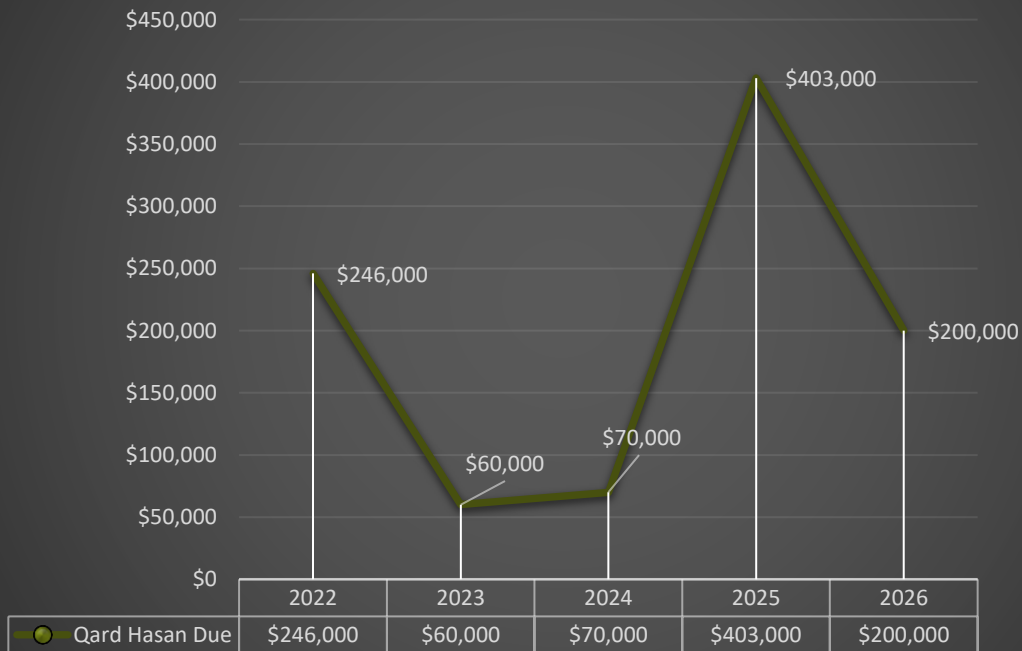

Project Risk:

1. Issue related to building fire code compliance could be a potential blocker, but we will not know the detail until we complete our application and site inspection. Building committee and BOT is working on this risk.
2. Paperwork for State and County Pending. Amendment in the ICM Articles is required to allow ICM Academy to operate under ICM as a tax-exempt entity. Initial Amendment was submitted March 23rd., 2022 and it was rejected. We are working to resubmit. Maryland Department Education application still pending due to the Amendment of Articles correction
